Getting iMovie Working

On your desktop there should be an icon called "iMovie Library Setup", This also available in Applications




A message will pop up explaining that when using iMovie the shortcut needs to be run. Alternatively an external USB can be used.

This will connect your Mac to your iMovie Library. You must run this each time you want to use iMovie on your network home. Alternatively store your iMovie library on a USB drive (recommended)

Continue...

When you double click on shortcut, you will be asked for your network password.

Click "Enable iMovie"



Wait for a few seconds or so....

iMovie will automatically load and mount the students Movies folder
